

Purpose of the VPMA Certified WDI Inspector Program

Since termites and most other wood destroying insects are generally hidden from view, it takes a trained professional to carefully detect conducive conditions, to know the habits and damage of each insect and to pinpoint signs of infestations. Sending a technician out to perform WDI Inspections without this training can lead to missed signs of infestations, inaccurate reports and big headaches for your company.

NEW to the Course: Our team will teach you how to use the new NPMA-33 form which is required for use beginning on Jan. 1, 2020.

WDI Program Specs

- Attendance does not ensure certification. Each participant must pass a 50 question multiple choice, true/false format exam administered at the end of the workshop, with at least a 75%.
- This is a voluntary certification and is NOT required by VDACS.
- Certification is good for two years - use this course to recertify, if you need to!
- If participant does not pass the exam, he must retake the exam within 6 months at a regularly scheduled course and test date, or with an authorized proctor. Retest will be \$25.
- Each participant must be employed by a VDACS-licensed pest management company and have minimum certification in category 60 (registered technician).

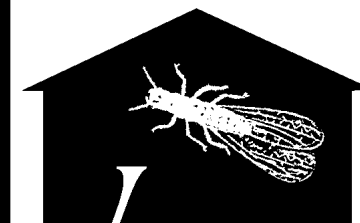
